

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Overnight snow will add to the substantial existing deposits of unstable windslab on North through East to South aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Soft cornices on these aspects will be unstable and prone to collapse. Other aspects will tend to be scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

After a few overnight snow showers a generally dry day is expected. North-Westerly winds will ease and become light and variable. The freezing level will be around 500 metres.
