

Wind Slab





Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Significant areas of moderate and poorly bonded windslab will persist on mainly North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Other aspects may be affected by wind redistribution of the snowpack. Some weak cornices will remain. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

There may be a few light overnight snow showers, after which it will remain generally dry. Easterly winds will back to the North and strengthen. The freezing level will be around 600 metres.
