

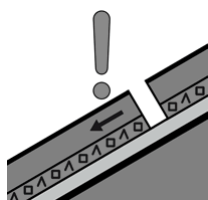

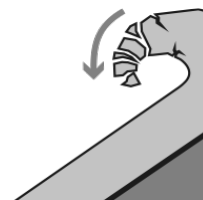

Wind Slab



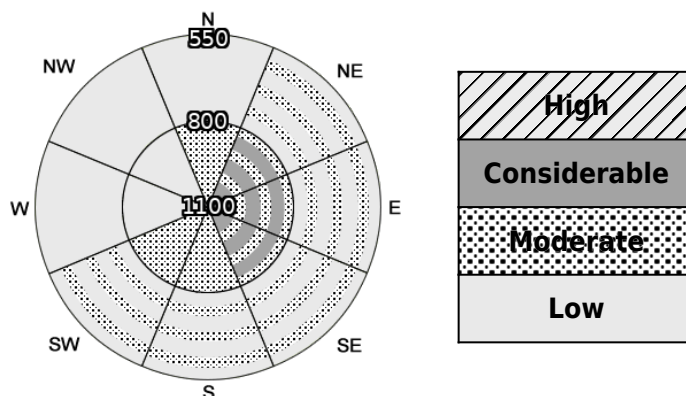
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A little thin new windslab on steep South to West aspects above 900m. Minor wet surface snow instability on steep South aspects exposed to prolonged sunshine. Consolidating trend will continue in other locations below 800m. Localised instability will persist in windslab on steep North-East through East to South-East aspects above 900m. Large weak cornices will be present over all these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Staying cold with a little light overnight snowfall. Winds will be moderate North Easterly freshening later.

Comments

Classic early spring mix of consolidating snow in some places and localised instability in cold snow at higher altitudes. Large cornices over NE to SE aspects.
