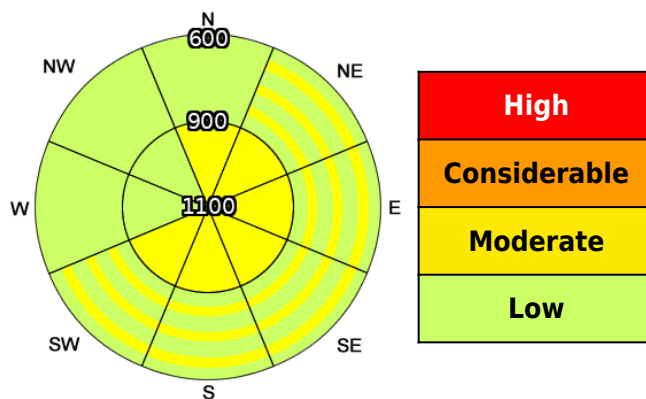

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Small accumulations of fresh slab will develop on mainly steep South to West aspects above 900m. Pockets of latent localised instability will persist where pockets of deepest windslab exists on steepest North East through East to South East aspects above 900m. Large suspect cornices will be present over all these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining cold with a little light overnight snowfall. Winds will be moderate North North Easterly becoming North by afternoon.

Comments

Poor visibility on summits, snow cover from 400m; remains good on tops.
