

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 06/03/2016


Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected in the snowpack. Some instabilities will remain within various layers of windslab, particularly in steep sheltered locations. North-East through East and South to South-West aspects above 800 metres most affected. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain generally dry through the period. Northerly winds will ease, and become light and variable. The freezing level will be around 400 metres.
