

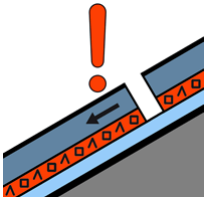

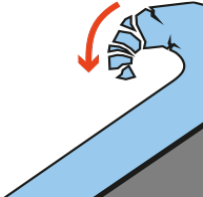
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



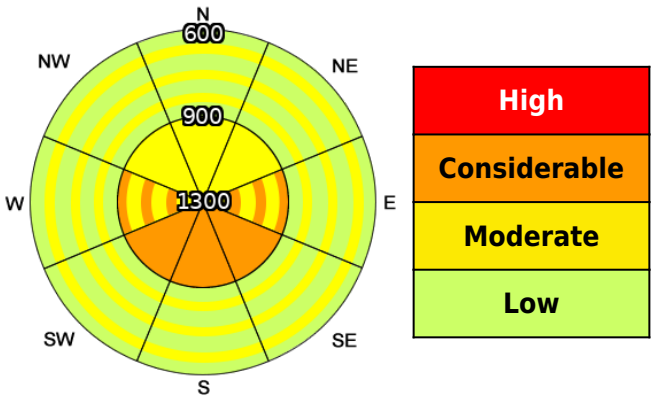
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poorly bonded windslab will persist on South-East to South-West aspects mostly above 900 metres. Localised cross loaded accumulations will lie on East and West facing slopes. All other aspects will be affected by unstable snow in areas of steep sheltered terrain. Soft cornices will be unstable. Localised unstable snow will affect steep slopes at lower altitudes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snowfall will continue through the night at all levels before clearing to leave a dry day. Moderate winds will be of a Northerly direction. The freezing level will be around 400 metres.
