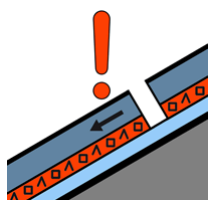


## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

#### Avalanche Problems



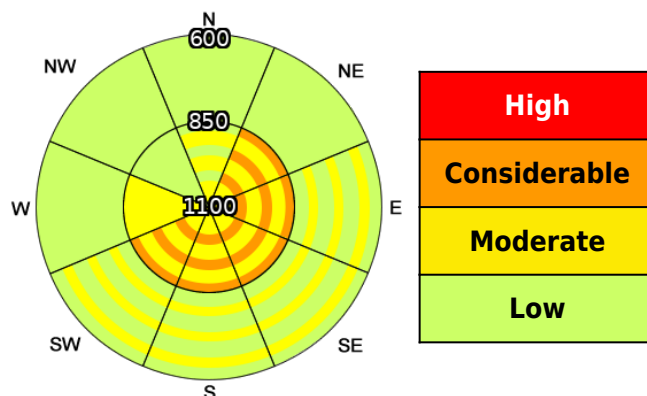
Persistent Weak Layers

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain well consolidated in most locations below 800m. Localised instability will persist on steeper South to South-West aspects above 850m. Pre-existing cross-loaded windslab in some steep East and West facing gullies above 850m will remain marginally bonded. Residual localised instability in deeper snow on some very steep, sheltered North-East aspects above 900m. Better stability on wind-exposed locations. Large cornices. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



#### Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation is forecast. Moderate generally Northerly winds easing to light by dawn. Remaining very cold.

#### Comments

Wide variety of snow surfaces depending on altitude and exposure to, or shelter from, wind and sun. Complicated early spring conditions!
