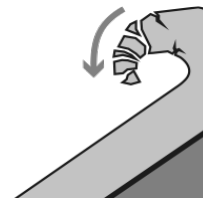

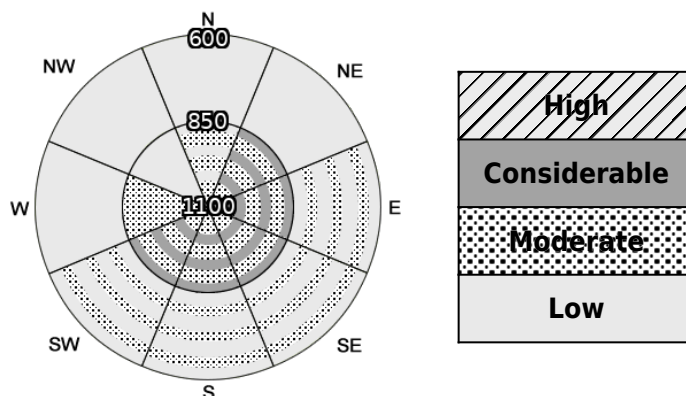

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised drifting with accumulations on steeper South-East to South-West aspects above 850m, cross-loaded marginally bonded windslab will also exist in some steep East and West facing gullies above 850m. Residual localised instability in deeper snow will persist on some very steep, sheltered NE aspects above 900m. Better stability on wind-exposed locations. Large cornices. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining cold. Some light snow showers overnight, dry by day. Moderate North-Easterly winds overnight becoming North-West then West as day progresses.

Comments

Widespread breakable crust persisting above 600m away from the trodden trail.
