

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Localised areas of unstable windslab will persist mainly on North-East through South-East to South-West aspects above 800 metres. At lower levels some localised instabilities will remain on very steep slopes otherwise the snowpack is generally well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Moderate North-West wind veering North-East this evening then backing West. Light snow showers initially then mainly dry. Freezing level rising to 500 metres during the day.

**Comments**

Large cornices above North-East to South-East aspects.
