

Wind Slab





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Due to redistributed snow and new deposits significant areas of unstable windslab will build on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. There will be little change on other aspects where localised moderately stable accumulations will persist. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light Westerly winds will back South-South-West to South-West, becoming strong to gale force overnight, before veering West-South-Westerly later. Snowfall overnight and during the day. Freezing level will be around 500 metres rising to around 700 metres.
