

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh areas of unstable windslab will develop during the period. Redistribution of existing soft snow will also occur. Unstable accumulations will initially be greatest on steep North-West, North and North-East aspects above 800m but will form on East and South-East aspects during the morning. Wind exposed slopes will be generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Southerly winds will increase from the South overnight before veering to the South-West to West during the day. Snow showers are expected above 600m.
