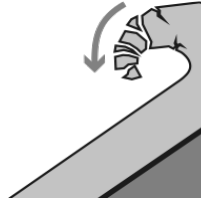

Wind Slab



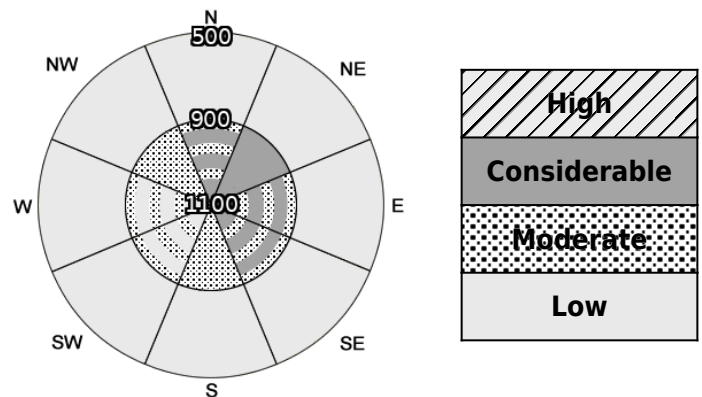

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Instabilities will persist on steep North through East to South-East aspects above 900m. Good stability on all aspects below 800m. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation is forecast. High pressure will bring cool, settled conditions. Winds initially light, variable and generally Northerly will veer later increasing East, through to South, then South West by end of the day.

Comments

No cover below 400m - good cover with lots of snow still in highest elevations.
