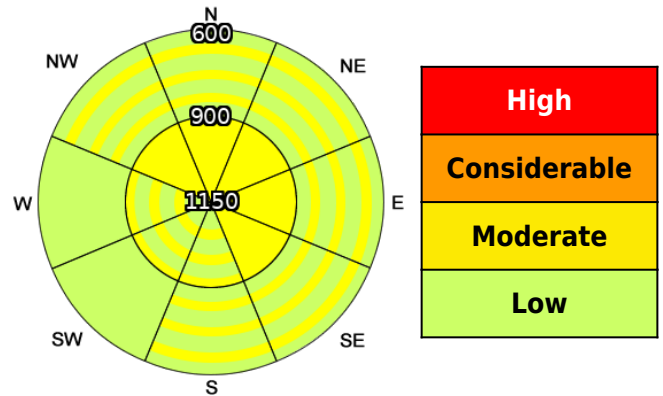

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Above 900 metres the snowpack will consolidate as temperatures rise during the day however, snowpack instabilities will remain mainly on steep North-West through North to South-East aspects with wet snow instabilities developing. Below 900 metres localised wet snow instabilities will exist on many steep slopes. Cornices will be prone to collapse affecting the slopes below. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



**Forecast Weather Influences**

The freezing level will rise and be above the summits. The winds will be fresh, generally from a Southerly direction. Mainly dry with light precipitation (rain) possible later in the day.

**Comments**

Mild conditions are expected to last through the week-end with the freezing remaining above the summits.
