

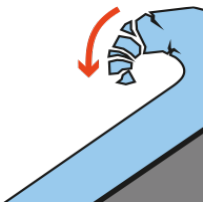

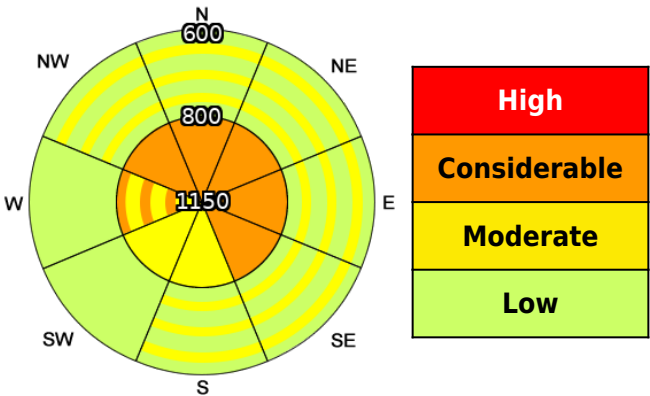
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Rain will saturate the snowpack leading to wet snow instabilities on all aspects and avalanches are likely. Areas mostly affected are North-West through North to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Cornices will be prone to collapse affecting slopes below. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain well above the summits. Precipitation will fall as rain through the period and will be heavy and persistent on occasions. The Southerly winds will be strong, gusting gale force at times.

Comments

The rain should ease on Saturday night then dry conditions should prevail the freezing level still above the summits.
