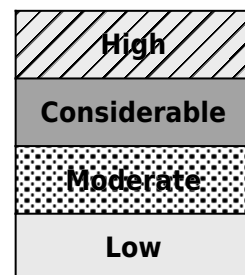
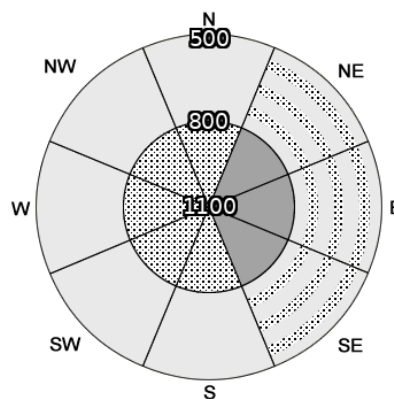
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Persistent rainfall and mild temperatures will maintain deep wet snow instability on all North-East through East to South-East aspects above 800m. All large cornices will become wet and prone to sudden collapse. Minor wet surface snow instability possible on a wide variety of other very steep aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining wet and relatively mild throughout. Strong South or South-West winds.

Comments

Dreich on Friday. Some very large and weakening cornices above most steep North-East through East to South facing lee slopes.
