

Persistent Weak Layers





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The diminishing snowpack will be patchy and wet at all levels. Localised and deep wet snow instabilities will persist, mainly on steep convex slopes on North through East to South-East aspects above 700 metres. Elsewhere, the snowpack will continue to consolidate. Many summits and summit ridges, particularly on Westerly aspects, will be bare of snow. Remaining cornices will be unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The light rain at all levels will die out overnight to give a mainly dry and cloudy day. Continuing mild, with the freezing level above the summits and the strong South-South-West wind will gradually ease during the day.

Comments
