




Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected to the snowpack. Overnight rain will continue to penetrate the snowpack maintaining wet snow instabilities on all steep aspects. Areas mostly affected are North-West through North to South-East aspects above 850 metres. Cornices will be prone to collapse affecting slopes below. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, some patchy light rain, drier conditions during the day. The freezing levels remaining well above the summits throughout the period. Winds, South-South-Westerly strong at first, easing gradually through the day.

Comments

Outlook: Mainly dry. Freezing levels remaining above the summits but wet bulb freezing levels may dip to 1000m later Monday, with some overnight crisping of the snowpack.
