





Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate at all altitudes. Localised instabilities will persist mainly within deeper accumulations on steep and convex North-East to South-Easterly aspects above 950 metres. Elsewhere will be mostly stable with some isolated wet snow instabilities affecting steep terrain. Old cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Mild conditions will continue with some patchy drizzle overnight, this will clear to leave a dry day. Strong South-South-Westerly winds will decrease moderate to light through the day.
