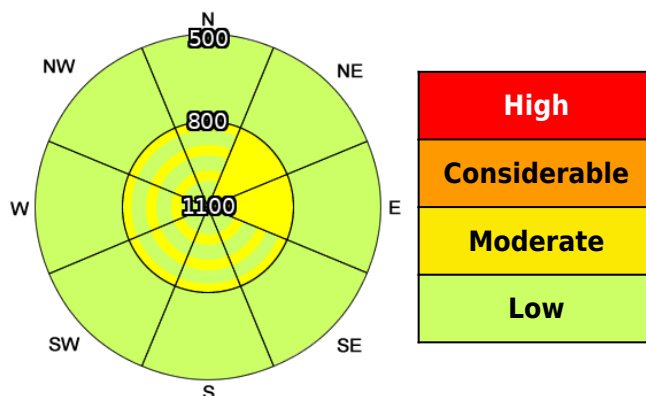
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Below 800 metres the snowpack will remain consolidated and generally stable. Above this level some wet snow instabilities will persist with North-East and East aspects most affected. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South-South-West winds overnight becoming moderate by daytime. Showers in the evening then mainly dry. Freezing level above the summits.

Comments

An area of high pressure moving in should give good weather from tomorrow onwards.
