






Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate but gradually thaw at all levels. Generally, snowpack stability will be good, however, on some steeper slopes, localised shallow areas of wet snow instabilities will be present above 900 metres with North-East and East aspects mostly affected. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse affecting the slopes below. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, a frost to lower levels, it will remain dry and mild through the day, the freezing level will be well above the summits. The winds will be light to moderate to fresh from an Easterly direction.

Comments

Today there was plenty of evidence of cornices collapses. Mild conditions are forecast to continue for the next couple of days.
