

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 15/03/2016


Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The overall snowpack will remain well bonded and stable. Remaining cornices especially on sun exposed slopes will be prone to slumping and collapse. Some sloughing possible on sun exposed steep slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate East -South - East winds will veer South - East to North - East in the early hours and then back East - North - East, turning fresh Easterly by the end of the period. No showers are expected. The freezing level will remain above the summits although under the inversion conditions some patchy overnight frost is possible in the glens.

Comments

A beautiful day here in the North - West, good walking and travel conditions. For winter climbing the buttresses are stripped.
