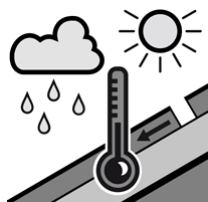


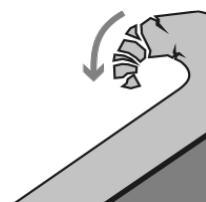

#### Avalanche Problems



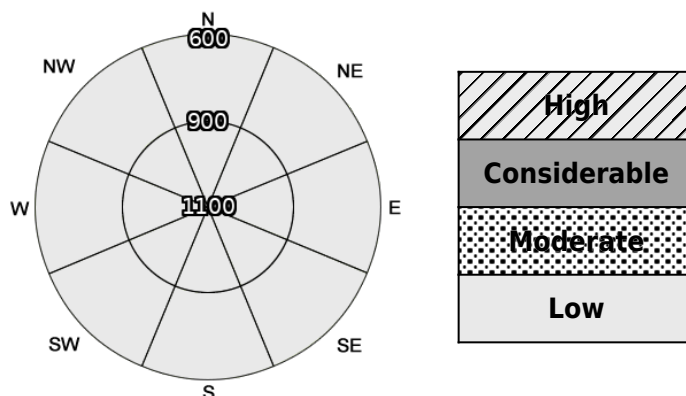
Wet Snow

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snow stability will be generally good as the snowpack continues to consolidate at all levels. Localised wet snow surface instabilities will exist above 900 metres on steep North through East to South-East aspects, most notably on East to South-East aspects exposed to solar radiation. Cornices above these aspects in particular remain suspect. The avalanche hazard will be Low



#### Forecast Weather Influences

High pressure will maintain dry and settled conditions. Freezing levels remaining well above summits. Cooler in valley floors overnight due to temperature inversion. Winds will be generally Easterly light to fresh.

#### Comments

Fine spring weather. Reasonable snow cover still in place in high plateau areas.
