

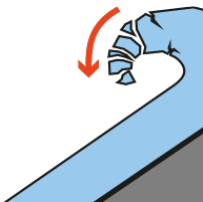

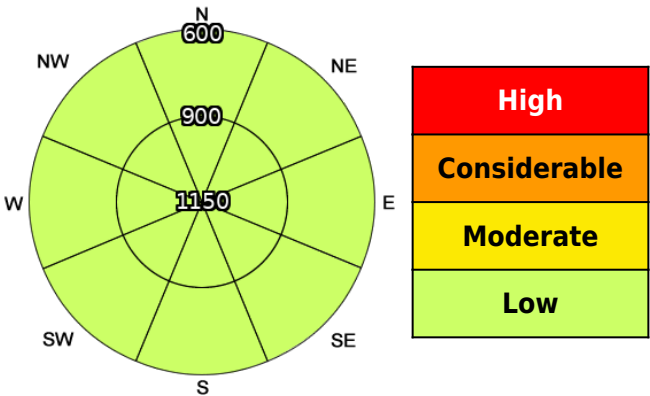

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate. It will be generally well bonded in all areas. During the day as warm temperatures and direct sun affect steeper slopes, localised areas of wet snow instabilities will develop above 900 metres with North-East and East aspects mostly affected. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse affecting the slopes below. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, fresh Easterly winds will decrease and back to East-North-East. High pressure will maintain dry settled conditions. The freezing level will be well above the summits.
