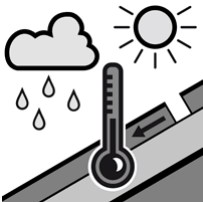


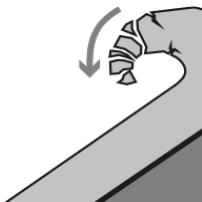

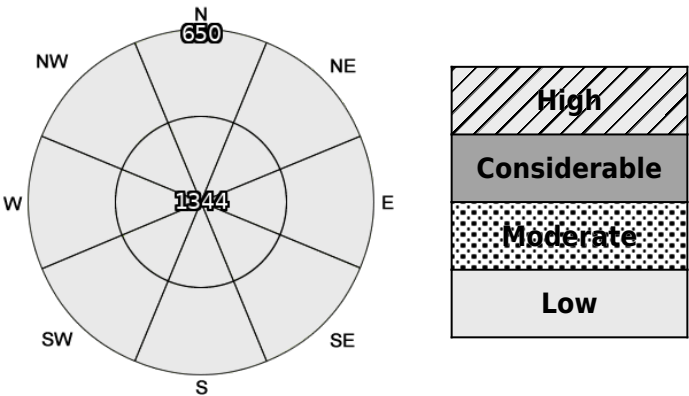
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack is expected to freeze at all levels overnight and will be generally stable. Slopes exposed to the sun will soften during the day and localised surface wet snow instabilities will be present mainly on steep East to South aspects. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light to moderate South-East wind backing North-East. Dry and Clear. Freezing level above the summits.
