





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will become firm overnight and will be generally stable in all areas. Later in the morning, warm temperatures and sun affected slopes will produce surface instabilities on steep mostly East to South facing slopes. Above the same aspects, any remaining cornices will continue to break off and collapse onto slopes below. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Little change is expected with high pressure system providing good weather. Winds will be generally light Northerly. Freezing level will remain above summits and no precipitation is expected.

Comments

Snowpack firming up well overnight and only diminishing slowly.
