
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to slowly thaw and consolidate and will be generally stable at all levels. Later in the day, some surface wet snow instability possible on steep sun exposed slopes mainly East to South aspects above 700 metres. The snow will be much firmer in permanently shaded areas most notably with a Northerly aspect. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain warm and dry with a light North-East wind strengthening in the afternoon. Some broken cloud is expected throughout the day.

Comments

Settled high pressure set to continue in the North West, but more cloud expected. Very good walking conditions.
