

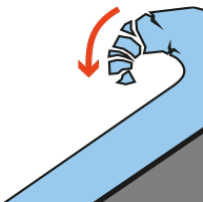

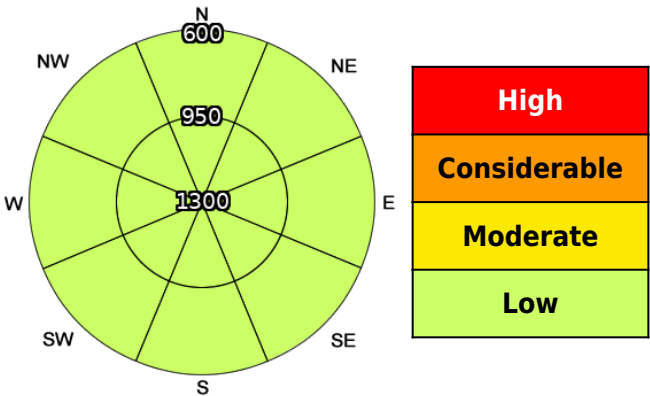
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will become firm overnight and be generally well bonded and stable in all locations. Slopes potentially exposed to any sunshine will be affected by surface instabilities. Remaining cornices on Easterly aspects could collapse affecting slopes below. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

High pressure will continue leading to settled conditions. After a sunny start fog is expected through the morning with clearer spells during the afternoon. Winds will be light to moderate Northerly and the freezing level will remain above the summits.

Comments

A very warm day; however only sun exposed slopes became soft. Shaded aspects remained firm.
