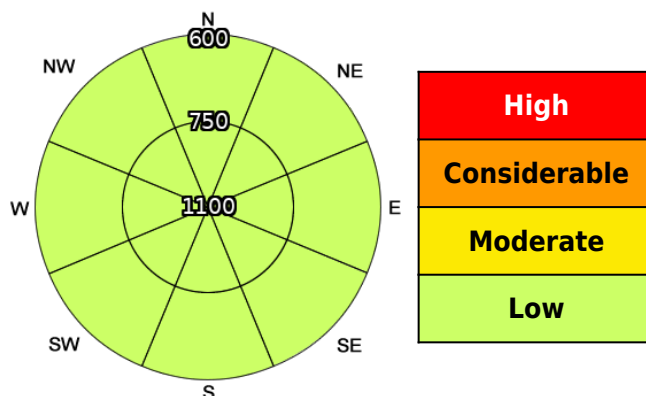
Wet Snow



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Firm and well consolidated snow on North West through North to North East aspects above 800m. Minor surface wet snow instability later in the day on steeper sun-exposed East to South aspects above 750m. Some potential for minor full depth avalanches from steep ledges on some crags. Cornices will become weak and prone to collapse. Glide cracks will continue to widen. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation is forecast. Dry, anti-cyclonic conditions. Cooler overnight and on shaded aspects during the day. Warm in sun-exposed locations. Light Northerly winds.

Comments

Collapsing cornices, falling ice and rocks and minor full depth avalanches remain the stand out issues at present.
