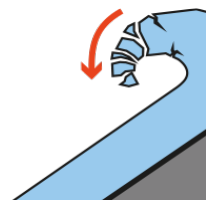
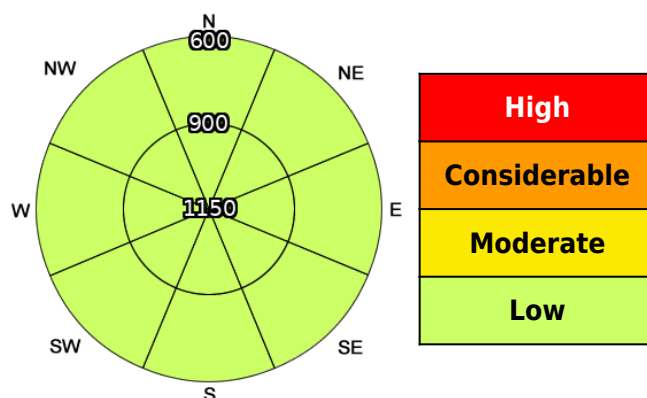


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 19/03/2016****Avalanche Problems****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will remain generally well bonded and stable with an icy surface in shaded areas. Solar warming will form shallow wet snow instabilities on affected steep North-East through East to Southerly aspects above 900 metres. Cornices will remain unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will remain dry and settled with light winds from a generally Northerly direction. Inversion conditions again tomorrow but possibility of higher clouds affecting the summits and giving sub-zero conditions within the cloud layer.
