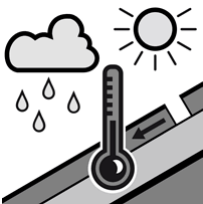


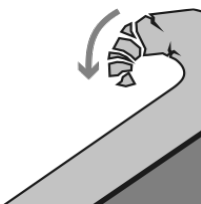

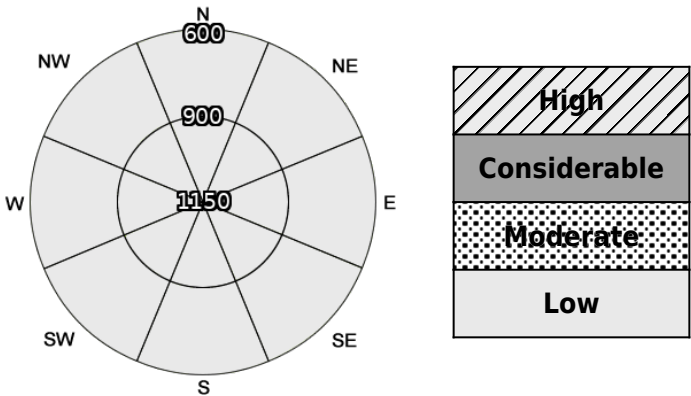
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will refreeze overnight and will be generally well bonded and stable with an icy surface in shaded areas. Solar warming will form shallow wet snow instabilities on affected steep North-East through East to Southerly aspects above 900 metres, remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry with light to moderate winds from a generally Westerly direction through the course of the day. Summit temperatures will be around zero.
