

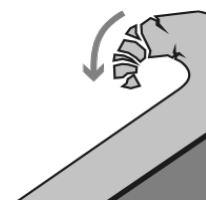

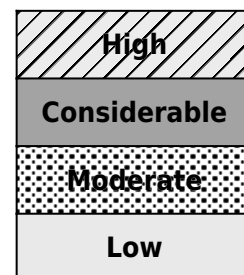
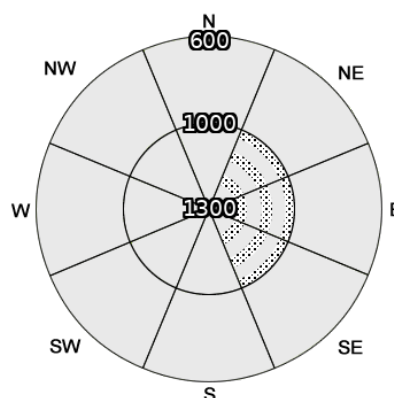
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will remain generally well bonded and stable in all locations. Localised accumulations of windslab will develop on North-East to South-East aspects above 1000 metres mainly around corrie rims and gully exists. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Some snow flurries expected above 750 metres. Light North-Westerly winds will increase to moderate through the day. The general freezing level will dip to around 1000 metres; however cooler layers will persist below this altitude.
