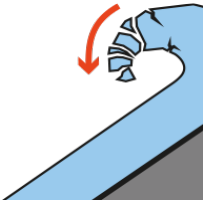

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 22/03/2016

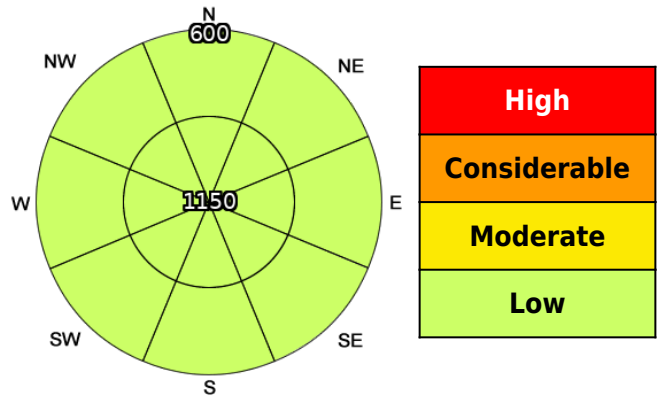
Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The spring snowpack will continue to slowly thaw and consolidate. Stability will remain generally good in all locations. Remaining sections of cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be a cloudy but generally dry day. The freezing level will be above the summits. Moderate Westerly winds will ease through the period.
