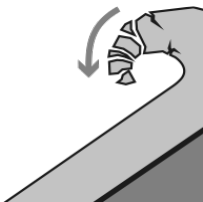


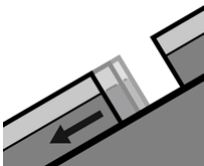

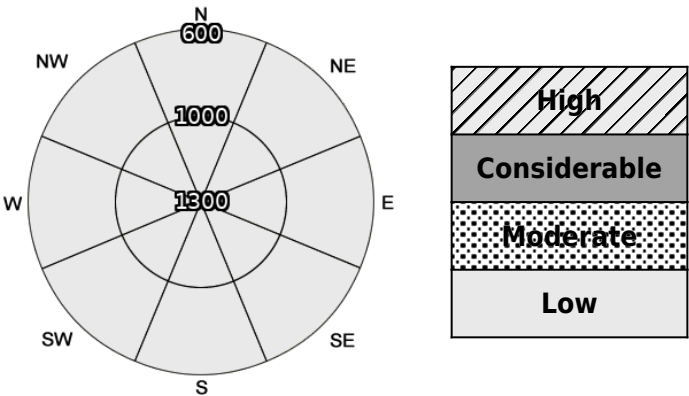

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack, which will be frozen and hard above 1000 metres, will remain well bonded and stable in all locations. Glide cracks will continue to develop on mostly Easterly aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation is expected. Freezing levels will be around 1000 metres overnight rising to above the summits in the day. Winds strong Westerly overnight becoming moderate to light in strength later in the day.
