



#### Avalanche Problems




Wind Slab

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will remain firm and stable in all areas. New isolated deposits of moderately well bonded windslab will continue to build on North to Easterly aspects above 900 metres. With the deeper deposits on steep and convex, wind sheltered terrain, gully exits, corrie rims most affected. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Freezing levels will be around 700 metres rising to around 1000 metres at the end of the forecast period. Occasional very light snow showers above 500 metres, overnight and during the afternoon. Winds will be strong Westerly backing South-South-Westerly and increasing in strength to storm force mid afternoon.
