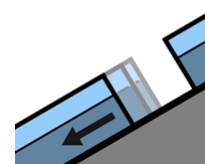

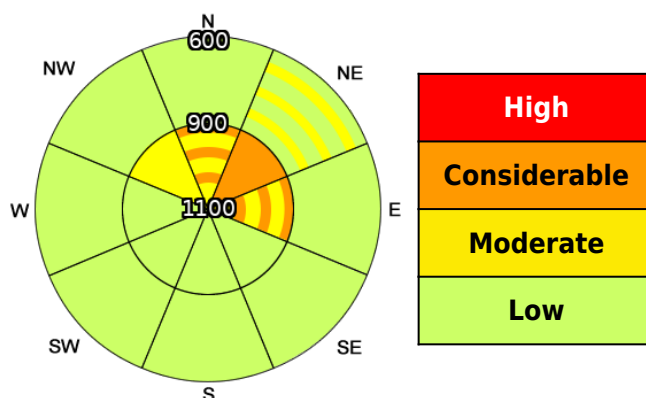

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will become wet but remain consolidated throughout. New windslab on North to East aspects above 900m will become wet and poorly stabilised as snow turns to rain and the freezing level rises above summits. New weak cornice development over steeper lee slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Temperatures rising and falling through freezing a few times during the forecast period. Depending on altitude, precipitation falling as snow or rain throughout. Strong South or South West winds easing to moderate later.

#### Comments

Poor mountain conditions expected on Saturday.
