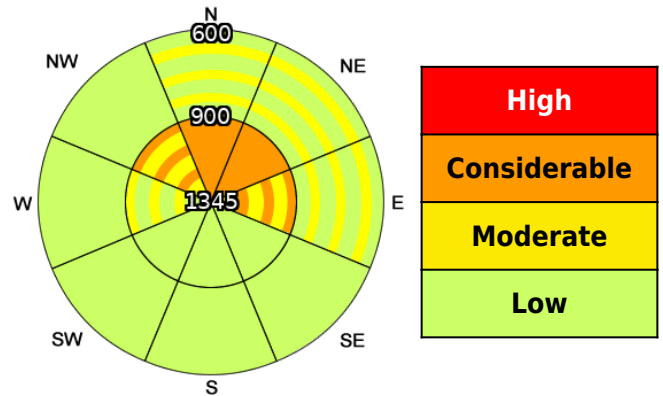

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh areas of unstable windslab will form on North, North-East and East aspects above 900m, notably gully tops and scarp slopes. Further windslab development is expected on North-West aspects during the day. Fresh cornices will form above these aspects. Exposed old snow will be frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South-Westerly winds overnight becoming moderate from the South during the morning. Heavy snow showers above 600m slowly dying out during the day.
