




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poorly bonded accumulations of windslab will develop on North-West through North to East aspects above 900 metres especially around corrie rims gully tops and steep, sheltered terrain. Localised windslab will form on other aspects due to cross loading. New fragile cornices will develop. Elsewhere the old snowpack will be firm and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Cooler temperatures arriving during the night with sleet turning to snowfall above 700 metres, this will be more showery through the day. Storm force South-West winds will back to the South and ease to strong. The freezing level will lower to around 800 metres.
