

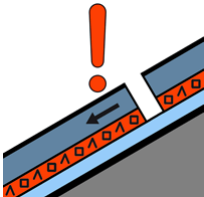

Wind Slab



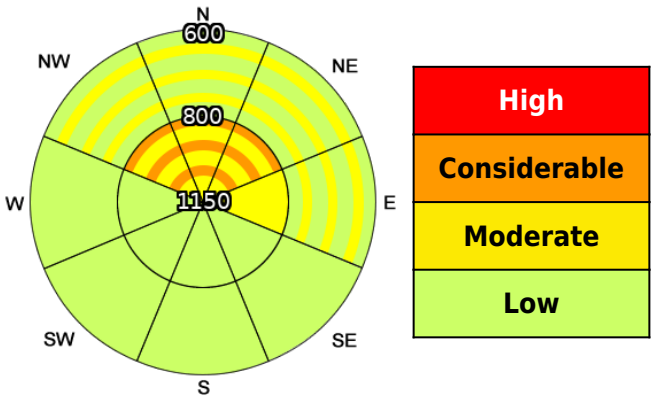
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The moist snowpack will consolidate as temperatures fall. New accumulations of poorly bonded windslab will form mainly on North-West to North-Easterly aspects, mostly above 800 metres with sheltered gully exits particularly affected. New, fragile cornices will develop on similar aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, the freezing level will fall to around 500 metres and rain will turn to snow showers, these will continue through the period with strong Southerly winds.
