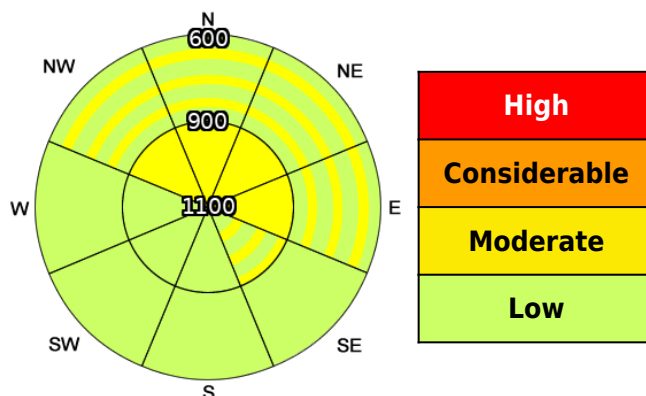
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snow showers will continue to add to the existing deposits of moderately bonded windslab, particularly on coire rims and at the tops of gullies. Most affected will be North-West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. Windward aspects will generally be scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

South-Easterly winds will veer to the West through the period. There will be a few showers, particularly overnight, which will fall as snow above about 600 metres. The freezing level will be around 700 metres, rising slightly towards the end of the period.

Comments

Showery Westerly airstream expected over the next few days.
