

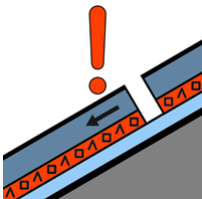

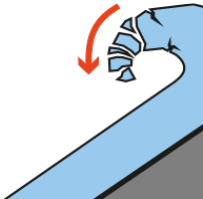

Wind Slab



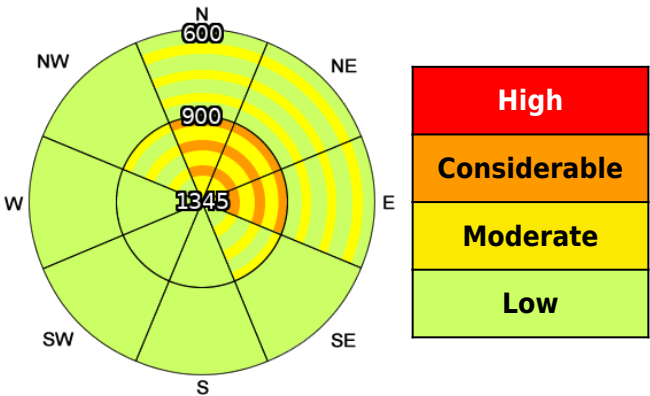
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of unstable windslab will be present, mainly at the tops of North, North-East and East aspects above 900m. Larger areas of moderately bonded snow will be present elsewhere on the same aspects. Fresh cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Light to moderate winds initially South-East and slowly veering to the West by the morning. Overnight snow showers above 700m
