
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will tend slowly consolidate in the slightly cooler conditions. However, fresh areas of windslab will be deposited on North to Easterly aspects above 900 metres, particularly during the afternoon. These area are not expected to be extensive. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be a few snow showers through the period, particularly during the afternoon. The freezing level will be around 700 metres. Moderate Westerly winds will back to the South-West.

Comments

Snowpack quite damp and sticky today with lots of small scale sluffing and roller balls observed.
