

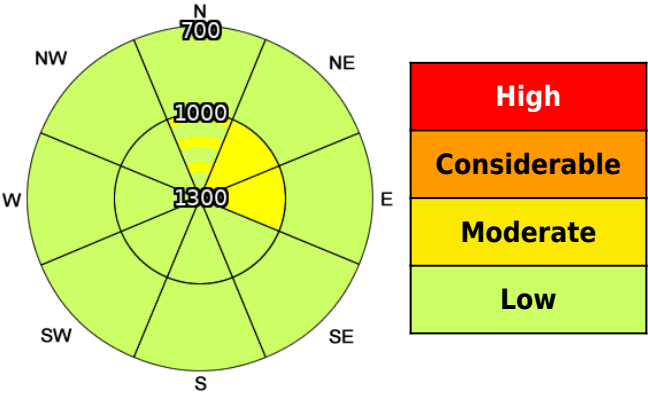

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 30/03/2016

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack although soft will continue to improve in most areas and will be generally well bonded and stable, however some instabilities will remain in isolated places in steep and convex terrain on mostly Northerly to Easterly aspects above 1000 metres with the deeper accumulations most affected. Surface instabilities are likely on many steep sun affected slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Freezing levels will be at 600 metres rising to 900 metres during the day. Mostly dry throughout the forecast period with the occasional snow showers overnight and during the afternoon. Winds mostly light to occasional moderate Southerly veering West then North-Westerly by the end of the forecast period.
