

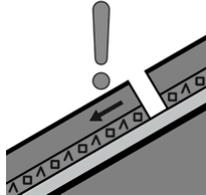

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 30/03/2016

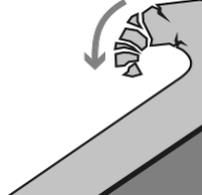
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab




Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will slowly consolidate. Instabilities will remain on mainly North to East aspects above 900 metres. Shallow deposits of fresh windslab will also accumulate on these aspects. In general the tops of slopes and gullies will be most affected. Some unstable sections of cornice will remain. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A few snow showers will affect the area through the period. Light mainly Southerly winds will become Westerly and strengthen through the day. The freezing level will be around 700 metres overnight, rising through the day.

Comments

Relatively settled weather conditions expected on Wednesday and Thursday. All change, and not in a good way, on Friday.
