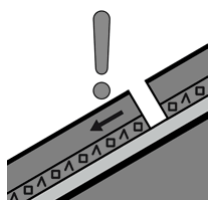

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 30/03/2016

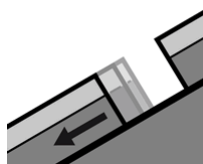

Persistent Weak Layers



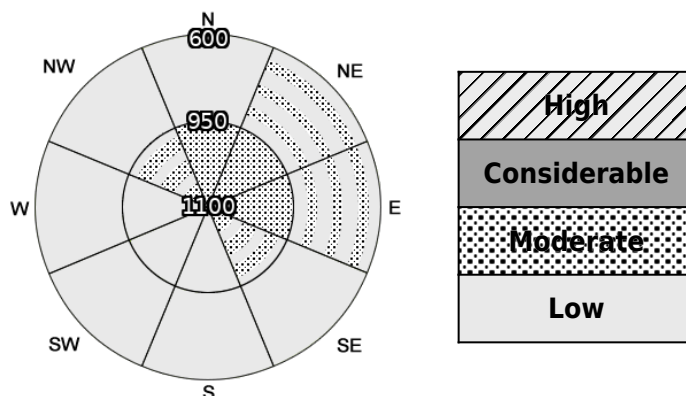

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Residual instability in deeper dry snow on very steep North to East aspects above 950m. Minor wet snow instability possible on any slopes exposed to strong spring sunshine. Some small scale full depth avalanche potential from steeply inclined benches and ledges on North East to South East facing crags. All recently formed cornices will remain suspect and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Light to fresh South Westerly later Westerly winds. Remaining cold but less so later. Generally dry but with some slow moving snow showers mainly from noon onwards.

Comments

A day of early sunshine and late slow moving snow showers.
