

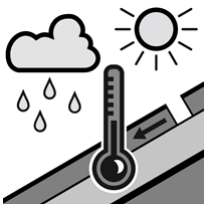

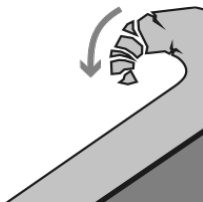

Wind Slab



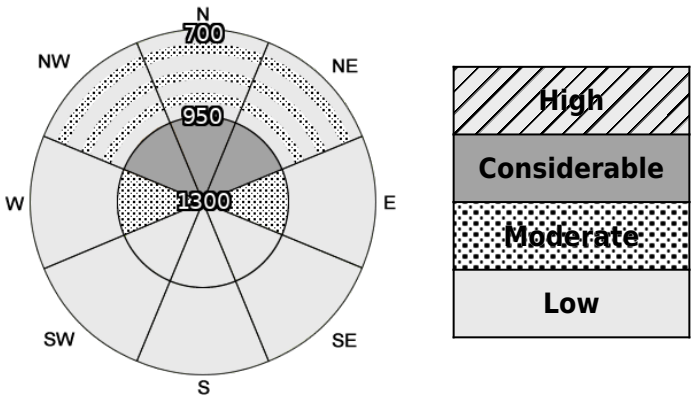

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of poorly bonded windslab will develop on North-West to North-East aspects above 950 metres. As the freezing level rises avalanches are likely on these aspects especially in areas of steep terrain. West and East facing slopes will be affected by windslab due to cross loading. Cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry overnight with moderate South winds. Snowfall through the day with South winds increasing strong to gale force. The freezing level will rise from 800 metres to summit levels during the morning.
