



Avalanche Problems




Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The wet snowpack will slowly consolidate in the general settled conditions. A few instabilities will remain on steep slopes on generally North to East aspects above 900 metres. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

After some further overnight rain an overcast but generally dry day is expected. Overnight the freezing level will drop to, and remain, around summit level. South-Westerly winds will ease and back to the South-East.

Comments

A very wet day on the hill on Friday, slightly drier conditions expected on Saturday.
