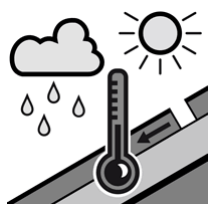


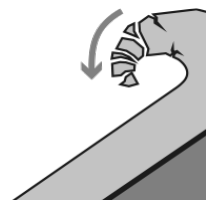

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 03/04/2016

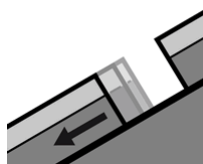

Wet Snow



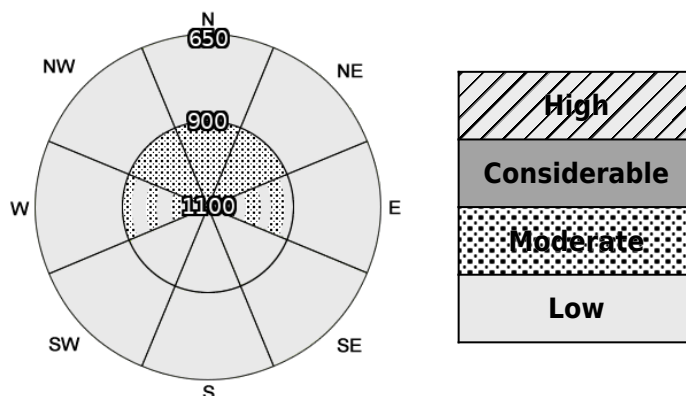

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will continue to slowly thaw and consolidate. A few shallow instabilities, both in the existing snowpack and in any fresh deposits, will persist on mainly North-West to North-East aspects above 900 metres. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain around summit level through the period. Some light precipitation both overnight and through the day will fall as wet snow on the tops, and as rain at lower levels. Moderate winds will vary between being from the South-East and the South.
