




Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will consolidate overnight as it cools and although softening in the day it will remain mostly stable on all aspects and at all levels. Some new snow accumulations will form above 900 metres but these are not expected to be significant. Some surface sloughs on steep North to East aspects are also likely during the day. Glide cracks due to snow creep on steep East aspects will continue to widen. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be moderate strength Easterly overnight veering South-South-Easterly and lessening slightly. Precipitation is expected overnight and during the day falling as rain at most levels apart from the highest summits where sleet and snow will lie. Freezing level will be mostly between 1000 - 1200 metres.
