Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

At summit level, some light deposits of fresh unstable windslab will form, mainly on West to North aspects. Below this level there will be localised areas of wet snow instability, mainly on steep ground above 800 metres. Elsewhere the snowpack will be further moistened and softened, but be generally stable. Remaining cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The wind will be fresh from a generally South-Easterly direction. There will be light showers throughout the period which will fall as snow at summit levels. The freezing level will vary between 900 and 1100 metres, rising in the afternoon.
