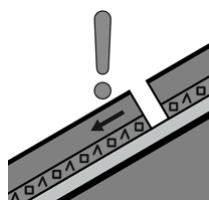


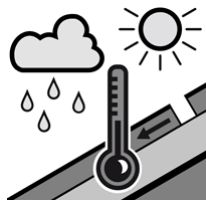

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 04/04/2016

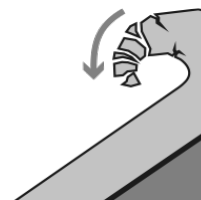

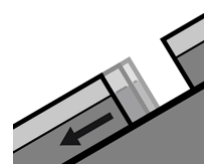
Persistent Weak Layers



Wet Snow



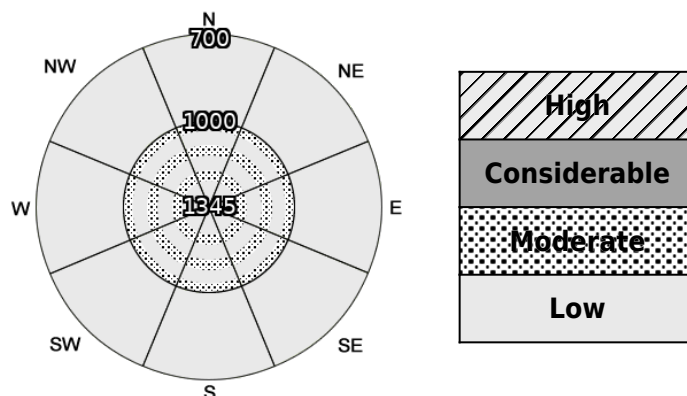
Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised wet snow instabilities will be present on all steep aspects above 1000m as the snowpack continues to thaw. Any remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Light to moderate South-East to North-East winds. The freezing level will be around the summits with the possibility of wet snow on the highest tops during the day.
